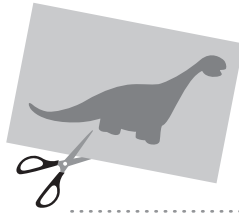


APPLY YOUR WALL STICKER GUIDE



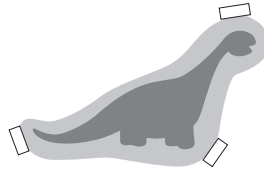
1. Prepare Your Surface

You need a smooth, dry and clean surface. To ensure such cleanliness, grab a cloth and give your surface a quick wipe down. Don't forget to wash your hands! You must leave at least 2 weeks freshly painted walls before applying your brand-new wall sticker.



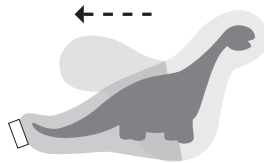
2. Prepare Your Wall Sticker

Depending on your pattern, you may need to trim around the decals before applying. Lay your wall sticker on a flat surface, graphic side down. Firmly rub or squeegee over the entire backing with squeegee, a credit card, your hand, a rubber spatula, etc... to shift the weight of your decal to the transfer tape.



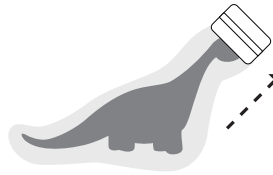
3. Plan Your Design

To avoid designer's remorse, tape your decals onto your surface before removing the backing. Plan the composition until you like what you see.



4. Remove Paper Backing

Start at one corner and slowly peel away with a rolling action. Some intricate patterns may want to stick to backing – simply stop peeling, roll back a bit and re-press decal onto transfer tape.



5. Stick and Smooth it

Stick top two corners of the transfer tape to your desired surface. Smooth it down starting from the center and move outward to avoid air bubbles and wrinkles; press and rub firmly as you go. Ask your friends for some help if the image is bigger than you can handle.



6. Remove Transfer Tape

Now that you've applied your graphic, it's time to remove the tape. Start at one corner & slowly roll it along the surface. If any part of the decal sticks to the tape, simply stop pulling, roll back a bit & re-press graphic onto your surface and continue peeling away, slowly.



7. WOW!!!

You may just have to call yourself an artiste from now on.

Bubbling may occur after graphics are applied. Using a thumbtack or needle, poke the bubbled area a couple of times, then smooth it out with your hands.

All Missiontoart wall stickers are made from opaque film from 3M - leader in professional adhesives - and designed to be removable so you can change your mind anytime. But once removed, they cannot be reused. Missiontoart products, however, can be used and repositioned as long as you keep the backing dust free. However, wall stickers are sensitive to extreme temperature and direct sunlight and due to variations in wall surfaces, Missiontoart cannot be held responsible for damage to surfaces.
